Did You Know?

The Thai government has launched an unprecedented crackdown on illegal business practices in the tourism sector.

Over **46,000 companies** are being targeted for investigation by the **Department of Business Development** and the **Department of Special Investigations** throughout 2025–2026, with nominee shareholder arrangements under intense scrutiny.

Many DMCs operating in Thailand **quietly breach** the Thai Foreign Business Act — using local nominee shareholders to disguise foreign control. This can expose you, as a travel professional, to significant reputational and operational risk if your supplier is deemed illegal.

Protect yourself and your clients:

- Ask your DMC partner to provide shareholder registration documents.
- Verify that Thai shareholders holding majority stakes are genuine decision-makers and financial beneficiaries — not “in name only.”
- If a company hesitates or refuses to share this information, ask yourself why — and consider the hidden risks you might be assuming.
- Choosing a legally compliant, majority locally-owned DMC like Tripseed ensures your business remains protected — and your commitment to ethical, responsible tourism remains intact.

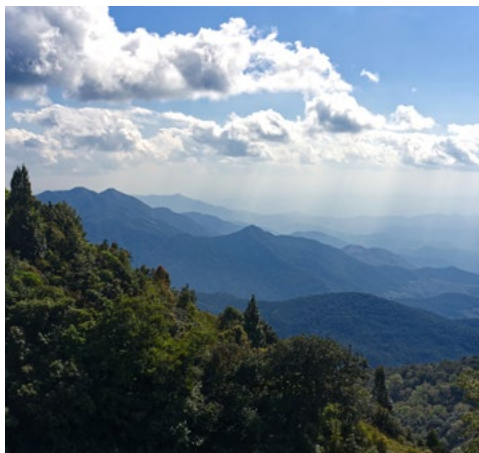
All wildlife experiences recommended by Tripseed are strictly observation-only, ensuring travellers encounter Thailand's majestic animals respectfully, without intrusive or exploitative contact.

While we recognise that some longstanding partners still offer interaction experiences, we work closely with them to encourage ethical transitions, using our influence to drive real change across the sector.



Yet genuine responsibility requires seeing the whole picture.

At Tripseed, we extend our animal welfare audits beyond animal treatment to include the wellbeing of mahouts, caretakers, and indigenous workers — recognising that true ethical travel must also protect human rights and livelihoods.



This focus is critical.

Tragically, over 100 human fatalities have occurred in Thailand over the past five years due to unmanaged human-elephant conflict, often in tourism-related environments.

By prioritising the welfare of mahouts and animals alike, we strengthen good health and wellbeing (SDG 3), advance decent work and economic growth (SDG 8), reduce poverty (SDG 1), and contribute to reducing inequalities (SDG 10).

Through detailed assessments, we evaluate whether sanctuaries:

- Provide fair, secure employment, including social security protections.
- Implement rigorous health and safety measures to protect both workers and visitors.
- Maintain conditions that offer dignity, stability, and pathways to economic resilience.



Safeguarding elephants and natural ecosystems also advances life on land (SDG 15) — preserving the biodiversity that makes Thailand extraordinary.

Genuine action requires reducing emissions at the source — not simply purchasing offsets to excuse business-as-usual operations.

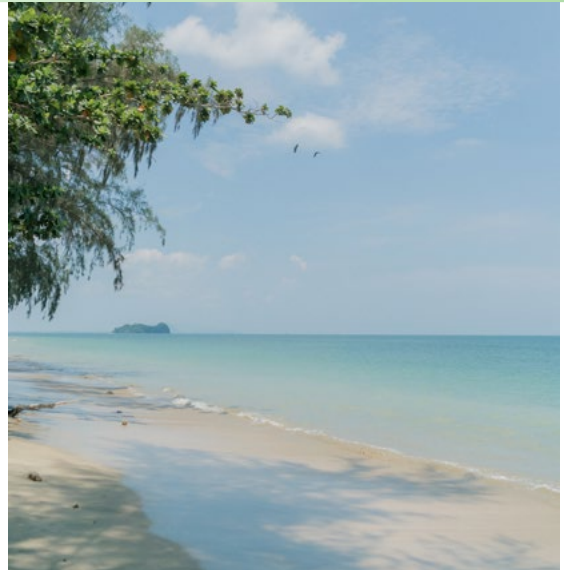
Unlike many legacy tourism companies now racing to retrofit sustainability practices, Tripseed was designed from the ground up with climate responsibility in mind. Our built-in operational efficiencies mean that our emissions per traveller are already lower by design.

This gives us a unique starting point:

Rather than pursuing arbitrary percentage cuts from a carbon-intensive baseline, we focus on absolute minimisation, continuous improvement, and radical transparency in everything we do.

As a founding signatory of the Glasgow Declaration for Climate Action in Tourism, we are committed to aligning our operations with the 1.5°C ambition, while remaining clear-eyed about the practical realities of achieving a Net Zero future for tourism.

Today, the vast majority of our carbon footprint lies in Scope 3 emissions which includes flights, transportation, and hotels that we do not own or directly control. While we cannot single-handedly transform these sectors,



we work relentlessly to source the most responsible options available, prioritise low-carbon choices across our itineraries, and encourage clients to book lower-impact trips — promoting longer stays, fewer internal flights, and more conscious modes of travel.

This effort alone cannot erase the industry's structural challenges.

But it represents an honest, tangible commitment to progress, and positions Tripseed at the forefront of climate leadership within a sector still finding its path forward.



Across our operations, we prioritise practical carbon reduction initiatives:

- Replacing combustion tuk-tuks with electric vehicles, leading the decarbonisation of urban experiences.
- Expanding the use of solar-powered boats to minimise fossil fuel dependency in river tourism.
- Elevating human-powered activities like trekking, kayaking and cycling, to make nature the heart of the journey, not just the backdrop.
- Advocating slow travel philosophies, encouraging longer stays and more immersive, lower-carbon travel choices.

Where unavoidable emissions remain, we contribute to verified climate action projects. But only after exhausting every reasonable step to reduce emissions at the source.

Offsetting must never be a shortcut. It is a bridge, used responsibly, towards genuine climate progress.

Through these efforts, Tripseed advances climate action (SDG 13), protects life on land (SDG 15), and supports responsible consumption and production (SDG 12).

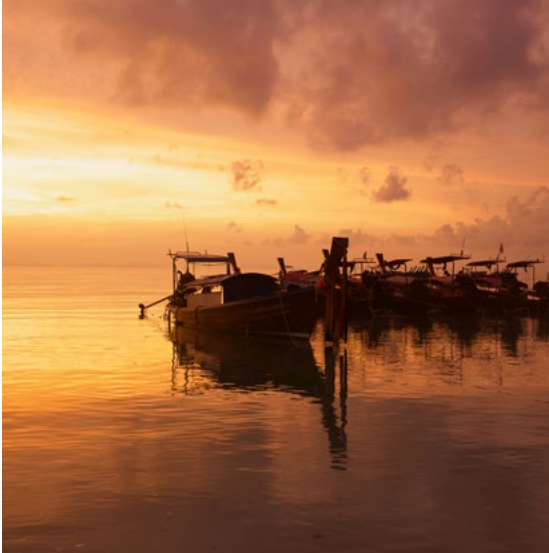
